Official Regulations

Article 1 - ORGANISER

The 6th edition of the Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race (*Course Eiffage du Viaduc de Millau en Aveyron*) is being organised on Sunday 22nd May 2022 by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association.

Article 2 - COURSE

The route is 23.7 kms long, has a total elevation gain of 390 m and includes a 1 km non-tarmac section. The first departures leave Millau at 9am – Boulevard de l'Ayrolle, at the old wash house (*lavoir*) near Place Frédéric Bompaire. This race begins by crossing the town as far as Millau Viaduct (running across the Viaduct itself and back again – a distance of 4,920 metres). The course continues as far as the finishing line, situated in the pathways of the Parc de la Victoire.

Article 3 – OFFICIAL JURY

The jury is composed of:

- The Chairman of the Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation association;
- The organiser;
- The race director;
- The coordinator in charge of security;
- The head of the medical team;
- The people in charge of the control zones concerned;
- As well as any person deemed competent by the Chairman of the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association.

The jury is entitled to give a ruling within a timeframe compatible with the race requirements on all disputes or disqualifications occurring during the event. The decisions are irrevocable.

Article 4 – REGISTRATION and COMMITMENT

4.1 Fees

The Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race is open to any person, male or female, born on or before 31st December 2002.

Online registration is possible on the www.course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org/ website, on the «Registration» tab in the main menu.

The registration fee is €45.

The **« company » rates**, or hospitality rates, are available to all companies who want to organise a team-building sports event. These «company» offers are available for consultation on the dedicated page of the website for the event or upon request by contacting: hospitalite@course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org

The **group rate** (minimum 20 people) is €39. This group rate includes the registration fee and group collection of runner numbers for associations and clubs.

The **student rate** is €25. A student card and proof of ID will have to be shown when collecting the runner number. (Up to the age of 26).

For online registrations on the www.course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org website, payment is by credit card.

No registration will be accepted without this payment, along with the documents mentioned in Article 6.

4.2 Capacity

The race is limited to 15,000 participants. No registration will be accepted beyond this limit.

No registration will be possible at the distribution centre (village) of runner numbers (Salle des Fêtes de Millau, Parc de la Victoire) on Friday 20th & Saturday 21st May 2022 (for opening times, see Article 7).

Every registration is final and cannot be refunded or transferred for any reason whatsoever (except in the case of cancellation insurance coverage). Any person handing over his/her runner number to a third party shall be considered as the sole responsible party in the event of the latter being either the cause or the victim of an accident during the race; the organisation accepts no responsibility in this type of situation.

The organisation reserves the right to be able to ban anyone having handed over and/or sold his/her runner number to a third party from taking any future part in the Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race.

4.3 Disabled Runners

The race is open to disabled runners except for wheelchairs, for security reasons due to the nature of the course.

4.4 Cancellation

Upon registering, any runner may opt for «cancellation guarantee» insurance (8 Euros). This will provide a refund of registration costs incurred (from which the cancellation amount is deducted).

A runner opting for «cancellation guarantee» insurance may request a refund in one of the following cases:

- Accident or illness resulting in a doctor's certificate covering the date of the race;
- Serious illness requiring hospitalisation during the thirty days prior to the race;
- Injury preventing any running, complete with medical justification dated less than thirty days prior to the race;
- Death of spouse or common-law partner or of first degree relatives, within the thirty days prior to the race.

Participants who have opted for «cancellation guarantee» insurance and who wish to cancel their registration, must make a written request along with the appropriate justification by e-mail (contact@course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org) or by registered post with acknowledgement of receipt within 10 days subsequent to the race. Requests are processed within two months of the race.

Article 5 - PUBLICATION OF REGULATIONS

The regulations may be consulted on the race website www.course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org or upon postal request to the following address: Association Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation - BP 60457 - 12104 Millau Cedex – FRANCE.

Article 6 – MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

The Organisation is entrusting DOKEOP SAS with the management of its written proof documents through its application. Its missions will be to:

- Collect the written proof documents of the participants that are registered for the event,
- Check that the written proof documents are legally compliant (legislation in French Sports Law article L231-2-1) and compliant with the federation rules,
- Regular follow-up emails for participants having not yet submitted their written proof documents,
- Communicate to the event Organisers the status of each written proof document that has been checked: valid / refused / awaiting document / awaiting validation,
- Archive written proof documents on a secured server.

To finalise his/her registration, each participant will receive an email from DOKEOP asking him/her to submit their document on the DOKEOP application. Using this application implies immediate and unconditional acceptance of DOKEOP's general conditions.

It is **ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY** that this written proof document be submitted via the DOKEOP application **before 11.59 pm on 15th May 2022**. No written proof document shall be accepted beyond this date.

You may submit:

- Either your medical certificate that is less than one year old on the day of the race (therefore dated after 22nd May 2021)
- Or a copy of your certificate of membership of the French Athletics Federation (FFA).

Each participant is free to create (or not to create) a membership account on the application. This application is separate from the registration platform.

In order to be valid, the medical certificate must contain the text stating: **«no contra-indication for practising sports in competitions» or «no contra-indication for practising running (or athletics) competitions».** The participant guarantees the accuracy of the data transferred, as well as the authenticity of the written proof document upon submission. In the event of absence of accuracy and/or of authenticity, the participant shall be unable to file a complaint, either against DOKEOP SAS or against the Organisation, particularly in the event of an accident occurring during the Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race.

No runner number shall be issued if the valid medical certificate has not been validated by DOKEOP SAS.

DOKEOP SAS reserves the right to refuse any document that it deems suspicious and possibly falsified when scanned under a laser detector. It should be noted that producing a false medical certificate is considered as a forgery and fraud crime: this offence is punishable under Article 441-1 of the Penal Code with sentences of up to three years' imprisonment and a fine of €45,000.

In the event of a medical certificate having been invalidated by DOKEOP SAS, under no circumstances shall the participant be entitled to request a refund of his/her registration fee.

Article 7 – RUNNER NUMBERS

The runner number must be worn on the runner's chest (using pins), worn horizontally and be <u>entirely</u> <u>legible for the full duration of the race</u>. Any runner not wearing a runner number will be removed from the race. No runner number may be given to or exchanged with another runner.

7.1 Conditions for collection

The runner numbers will be issued upon presentation of:

- the e-mail confirming registration;
- proof of identity;
- a medical certificate or copy of federation membership (for those who have not already submitted it);
- proof of student status provided by the student's educational establishment.

7.2 Place

Salle des Fêtes, Parc de la Victoire, Avenue Charles De Gaulle, Millau, France

- Friday 20th May 2022, 3-8pm;
- Saturday 21st May 2022, 9am-8pm.

For this 6th edition, no runner number shall be issued on Sunday 22nd May 2022, the day of the race.

7.3 Special cases

Runner number sent by post:

This option is only applicable for runners living in Metropolitan France (limited to 1,500 subscriptions, or the date limit of 27th April at 11.59am if this limit has not been reached).

Runners who have opted for their «runner number to be sent by post» (an option costing €10 to be chosen upon registration) shall receive their runner number before the race at the address indicated on their registration form. The runners shall then be able to collect their kitbag and t-shirt at the Salle des Fêtes in the Parc de la Victoire on Sunday 22nd May 2022.

The medical certificate must be addressed and validated no later than 11.59am on 27th April 2022. Otherwise, the runner number shall not be sent out, no refund shall be considered and the runner will have to go directly to the «Litigations» stand (*Litiges*) on 20th or 21st May 2022 at the *Village* at the Parc de la Victoire.

Collection by a third party:

The runner number may be collected by a third party upon mandatory presentation of his/her proof of identity.

• <u>«Elite and Preferential»</u> runner numbers:

There will be a stand for collecting «Elite and Preferential» runner numbers. The runner or his/her agent will be able to collect the runner number upon presentation of the runner's proof of identity. The performance certificate supplied must indicate a time that is faster than:

- For men: 35' for 10 kms, 1h20 for a half-marathon or 2h45 for a marathon;
- For ladies: 40' for 10 kms, 1h30 for a half-marathon or 3h00 for a marathon.

Article 8 - EQUIPMENT

No equipment is compulsory for taking part in this event, but water and calorific energy reserves are strongly recommended. Backpacks are forbidden in the 2022 Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race, except for simple water-packs (*such as Camelbak©*). Hydration belts with water bottles are also allowed.

Article 9 – BAGGAGE LOCKERS

The baggage lockers are located in the Salle des Fêtes of the Parc de la Victoire, and will be open on Sunday 22nd May, 7am – 2.30pm.

Article 10 – RACE ORGANISATION

Two drinks stations are located along the course as well as a 3rd in the arrival zone.

Race participants have a maximum of 4 hours (*i.e.* an average speed of 6 kph) to complete the course to the finish line. Furthermore, they must respect the cut-off times hereafter so as not to risk being eliminated from the race:

- 11.00am, 1st cut-off time: at the entrance to the motorway rest area, at the exit of drinks station n° 1 (8.3 kms)
- 11.50am, 2nd cut-off time: turning point located on the Millau Viaduct (12.8 kms)
- 12.15pm, 3rd cut-off time: at the exit of A75 motorway (15.7 kms)

Cut-off times are calculated according to the departure of the last wave. Runners who do not make the cut-off times will be taken back to Millau in a shuttle bus.

Once the sweep-up vehicle has come through, participants must respect traffic rules (Highway Code).

All runners pledge not to start before the departure and to cover the entire distance before crossing the finish line. Bicycles, wheeled vehicles (whether motorised or not) are absolutely forbidden along the course, except for those belonging to the organisers. Animals are also strictly forbidden along the course.

Reasons for disqualification

- Not wearing the runner number in its entirety;
- Not respecting entry to the departure zone in the space provided;
- Being accompanied by a cyclist, a motor vehicle or a runner not registered for the race;
- Being accompanied by an animal;
- Refueling with food/drink along the course outisde the drinks zones provided;
- Disposing of paper, empty bottles, energy bar or gel wrappers outside the specific zones provided;

- Not respecting the course in its entirety;
- Not respecting security measures (Operation Vigipirate);
- Not respecting volunteers and organisers;
- Giving your runner number to another runner;
- Not making the cut-off times imposed by the organisers;
- Not respecting doping bans as well as the anti-doping test rules, in accordance with the rules and regulations in force, particularly Articles L. 230-1 and following in the Sports Code.

It is the role of the inspectors who witness these irregularities to remove the offending runnners from the race. The inspectors are the guarantors of the ethics and spirit of the 2022 Eiffage Millau Viaduct Race in Aveyron.

Article 11 - MILLAU VIADUCT SECURITY RULES

While runners are crossing the Millau Viaduct, in both directions, a surveillance team will be in place to ensure that the following security rules are duly respected;

- do not change lane by crossing to the other side of the safety barriers;
- do not walk or run along the corniche between the security barrier and the wind-break screens;
- do not climb up on the wind-break screens;
- do not climb on to the security barriers or the low concrete walls;
- do not climb up or hang on to any signposts;
- do not litter the course (with empty bottles, or energy gel/bar wrappers).

Article 12 – GENERAL SERVICES

Due to the Operation *Vigipirate* in force, security will be increased during the race. Accordingly, runners must comply with the rules: searches, and frisking upon entry to the departure zones.

Medical assistance is provided by associations recognised by National Security and by private companies. They have the powers to remove a competitor from the race for medical reasons. The competitor's runner number shall be removed, thereby indicating his/her irrevocable removal from the race.

Any runner who has been removed from the race but who continues the event, will do so entirely at his/her own risk and the organisers shall not be held responsible in case of an accident.

Every runner grants the organisers permission to dispense medical care and/or hospitalisation in the event of an accident or emergency.

Article 13 - TIMING

The timing rules applicable to the Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race are as follows: real time for all participants.

Timing is calculated by means of a chip system that is attached to the runner number. This chip is triggered automatically at the start line and is used for measuring the participant's time over the entirety of the distance.

In order to be ranked at the finish line, the competitor absolutely must be timed at the following points: start line, North and South roadway expansion joints on the Millau Viaduct, as well as at the finish line. Any competitor not covering the entire distance shall not be ranked upon arrival.

All runners pledge not to start before the departure and to cover the entire distance before crossing the finish line.

Article 14 - RANKINGS AND CHALLENGES

The prize giving will take place on Sunday 22nd May starting at 11.00am, on the winners' podium in the Parc de la Victoire beside the arrival zone.

Rankings will be given for Overall Men and Women, and for each Men's and Women's category, in accordance with the timing rules mentioned in Article 13.

Reminder: the overall ranking is calculated based on real time (from the moment runners pass beneath the start gantry until the finish line).

Based on real time, the official ceremony will award:

- the first 3 men and the first 3 women in the provisional general rankings. Important: runners who would like to have the possibility of receiving an award at the official ceremony are obliged to start in the 1st wave start (Elite and Preferential).
- the first man and the first woman in each FFA category (from Juniors to Masters) as well as the winners of the three Challenges hereunder.

Specific rankings will be given for the following categories:

Challenge Club

To register for the «Club Challenge», the following information absolutely must be mentioned in the appropriate box in the registration form:

- the name of the FFA club
- FFA membership number

In order to be ranked in this challenge, the club must be an affiliated member of the FFA (French Athletics Federation) and have at least 5 race finishers. The ranking is calculated by accumulating the real-time race results of the 5 best club members. The team with the lowest total wins the «Club Challenge». If the event of a draw, the club with the 5th best time will be declared the winner.

Challenge Entreprise

In order to take part in the « Entreprise Challenge », it is essential to subscribe to a « hospitality » offer

To be classified in this challenge, the company must subscribe a hospitality offer and must gather at least 5 arrivals at the end of the race. The ranking is established by cumulating actual race times of the company's top 5 employees. The company with the lowest total wins the "Challenge Entreprises". In case of a tie, the company with the 5th best time will be declared the winner. To find out more, write to hospitalite@course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org

Number Challenge

To register for the «Number Challenge», the group (company, institution, association or club) must provide as many finishers as possible (at least 10). The ranking is calculated according to the companies providing the most finishers.

Article 15 - INSURANCE

It is clearly indicated that runners take part in the competition under their own, exclusive responsibility. Organisers decline all responsibility in the event of an accident or theft befalling competitors or third parties during the event. Federation members receive guarantees given by the insurance covering their federation. It is the responsibility of other participants to take out personal insurance. Insurance cover can be obtained from the company of the runner's choice, such as the FFA (French Athletics Federation). The organisers are covered by civil liability insurance.

Article 16 - IMAGE REPRODUCTION RIGHTS

By participating in the sixth edition of the Eiffage Millau Viaduct in Aveyron Race, each competitor expressly authorises the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association and the partners of the event, to use images taken during the race in whatever format he/she may appear, for an unlimited period of time, intended for direct utilisation or in derivative form. This authorisation is valid worldwide.

Article 17 – SANITARY MEASURES

In order to provide sanitary security for the runners, strict measures shall be implemented by the Organisers. These measures, ensuing directly from the appropriate authorities, will be the measures that are in force at the date of the event and must be respected scrupulously, subject to sanctions. A specific information sheet concerning these sanitary measures shall be published and distributed to all runners shortly prior to the date of the race.

Article 18 - PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

The Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation association is committed to personal data protection and has undertaken to ensure the security and confidentiality of personal data in accordance with the European Parliament (EU) Ruling 2016/679 and with the Council Regulation of 27th April 2016 relating to the protection of physical persons concerning the processing of personal data and their free movement («GDPR» hereafter), in particular by taking all the necessary precautions for preventing these data from being deformed or damaged or from unauthorised third parties having access to them.

Upon registering for a sports event organised by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association, the client is informed and allows his/her personal data to be:

- (i) collected on the https://inscription-event.com/cevma-2022 website, property of Avena Event, commissioned by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association;
- (ii) used by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association, acting as the party responsible for data processing in accordance with the GDPR and by Avena Event, its subcontracted service provider.

18.1 Identity of the party responsible for data processing

18.2 Data and information collected

The data collected are:

• Data required for registration for the sports event organised by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association:

Upon registering, you are required to supply the data indicated by an asterisk on the website: surname, first name, date of birth, gender, nationality, e-mail address, mobile phone, postal address, language, information concerning the person to contact in case of an incident during the race (surname, first name, telephone), singlet size, medical certificate for competition aptitude.

This list may change according to the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association's legal, technical or organisational constraints.

Optional data:

Upon registering, other data are requested but are not compulsory for your registration (name of the runner's club, home telephone number, etc.).

Furthermore, the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association or Avena Event may send you, subsequent to the sports event, one or several satisfaction survey(s) and may collect, on this occasion, supplementary data, such as: level of sport practised, consumer habits, socio-professional category, hobbies, participation in events, material and equipment used, etc.

• Data related to payment:

Upon registration, our banking payment partner collects and processes the data concerning your means of payment (bank card number, bank card expiry date, visual cryptogram security number (which is not withheld), etc.). The information about your means of payment given when you register are encrypted through a security protocol, and never circulate uncoded through the network. The data concerning your means of payment are never given to us by the banking partner.

Technical data:

The Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation association is liable to collect technical data such as connection data, the IP address in accordance with the applicable legislation, and where required with your consent, for the use of certain technologies such as cookies.

No sensitive data is collected, i.e. information concerning racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, philosophical or religious beliefs, trade union membership, etc. (GDPR Art. 9).

18.3 Data processing objectives

The *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association uses and manages your personal data for the following purposes:

- → Management and validation of sporting events organised by the Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation association,
- → Management of relaying information to the participant by email and/or text message about the event he/she has registered for (confirmation that the registration has been correctly taken into account, confirmation of the validation or refusal of the registration, information about the sporting event, results information, etc.).

Avena Event uses and manages your personal data for the following purposes:

- → Sending satisfaction surveys conducted for scientific or statistical purposes: (using opinion polls or questionnaires);
- ★ Conducting statistical reports;
- → Information concerning the offers and activities of the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association and other forms of related services;
- → Sending e-mails or text messages to inform you about sporting events that may interest you, organised by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association or a third party organiser;
- → Sharing data with our privileged partners (industry, media, institutions), so as to communicate promotional offers, advertisements and other commercial communication (subject to your prior agreement when required and to your right to opposition, in accordance with the applicable rules pertaining to commercial market research).

18.4 Data retention

Your data will be retained for the duration deemed necessary concerning the purposes formerly mentioned.

Your data will be deleted if you do not reply to any of our requests over a period of three years.

We may however retain your data for a longer period in order to respect our legal and regulatory obligations, or for litigation resolution.

18.5 Data recipients

The personal data collected during your online registration may be sent to:

- → The internal departments of the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association (administrative staff, employees and officials);
- → Service providers and contract partners of the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association working on and contributing directly to the management of registrations and the organisation of the sports event (timer, manufacturer of runner numbers, company in charge of medical assistance, etc.);
- → Privileged partners of the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association (industrial, media, institutions), with your permission, in order to offer products and/or services for commercial market research and/or for advertising communication.

The *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association asks its service providers and partners to implement strict confidentiality and data protection measures.

If you have given specific consent upon registration by ticking the appropriate box, you are liable to receive promotional offers by telephone and/or post or e-mail or text message from our commercial partners to whom your data may be transferred and yielded for commercial market research purposes. In any event, you may object at any moment according to the conditions mentioned hereafter.

By choosing to take part in the sports event, participants acknowledge and accept that:

- → Their surname and first name(s) appear on the official starting list published on the https://www.course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org/accueil/ website;
- → After the sports event, information concerning their sporting performance (especially results, photos and videos) be published on the https://www.course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org/accueil/ website; with the likelihood that the aforementioned results be used by any media.

Should you wish to objet to such publication for a legitimate reason, you absolutely must send this decision, in writing, to our subcontractor at the following address: Avena Event - Traitement des données personnelles Course Eiffage du Viaduc de Millau en Aveyron - 33, rue du Général Leclerc - 92130 Issy les Moulineaux, France, no later than one month prior to the sports event so that adequate measures may be taken.

Apart from the above-mentioned cases, the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association agrees not to sell, rent, give access to or hand over your collected data to third parties without your prior consent, unless being forced to do so for a legitimate reason (legal obligation, combatting fraud or abuse, exercising defence rights, etc.).

Some of the above-mentioned recipients may reside outside the European Union and may have access to all or part of the personal information collected by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association.

You expressly agree that your data may be forwarded to service providers or partners outside the European Union.

In this context, the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association agrees to guarantee the protection of your data in compliance with the strictest rules, particularly by signing, on a case-by-case basis, contract clauses based on the European Commission model, or any other mechanism conforming to GDPR, once your personal data have been processed by a service provider outside the European Economic Area and whose country is deemed to have inadequate protection levels by the European Commission.

18.6 Commercial offers

The Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation association and its sub-contracted service provider Avena Event are liable to send you information by post, e-mail, text message or telephone concerning their offers and services similar to those you have purchased, which you acknowledge and accept.

You reserve the right, at any moment and free of charge, to object to receiving these commercial market research messages according to the conditions stipulated hereafter.

18.7 Rights of the person concerned

In accordance with the amended «IT liberties law» of 6th January 1978 and with GDPR, persons concerned by the processing of personal data have the right to access, to rectify and to delete data concerning them, as well as the right to limit and to oppose processing and portability of their personal data. You also have the right to oppose processing of your personal data for marketing reasons by the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association and/or its partners.

By virtue of Article 12.3 of GDPR, the *Course Viaduc Millau Aveyron Organisation* association undertakes to supply the person concerned with the information about measures taken following a request concerning the aforementioned rights as soon as possible and, in any event, within one month of having received the request.

If you do not wish to receive any/any more of our offers, requests and news, you also have the possibility of informing us by clicking the unsuscribe link at the bottom of each message.

If you do not wish to receive news, invitations or promotional offers from our partners, you have the possibility of informing us upon registration by ticking the appropriate box.

These texts may be subject to updating. Modifications will come into effect upon publication of the new version on the https://www.course-eiffage-viaducdemillau.org website.

Article 19 – IN CASE OF FORCE MAJEURE

In case of *force majeure*, of natural catastrophe, or of any other circumstance endangering the security of competitors, the organisers reserve the right to modify the course or the start time, as well as the right to cancel the event, without participants being able to reclaim any refund whatsoever.

Article 20 – VARIOUS PROVISIONS

Every competitor acknowledges having taken note of the present rules and accepts all the clauses.

Use of devices for listening to music is tolerated by organisers. However, for obvious security reasons, organisers strongly advise against the use of headsets that may prevent you from listening to your own environment during the race. Use of these devices is under the participant's sole responsibility.
